End of Year SMARTR Outcome
Unadjusted math SOL scores will increase by at least 10% to at least 70% for economically disadvantaged students and 53% for special education students by June 2020.
Strategy 1 Instructional coach for math.
Strategy 2 Implementing intervention throughout the entire school year.
End of Year SMARTR Outcome
Unadjusted SOL scores for special education students will increase by at least 10% to 53% in math and 73% in English by June 2020.
Strategy 1 Professional development for all special education teachers.
Strategy 2 Implementing intervention throughout the entire school year.
End of Year SMARTR Outcome
The dropout rate will decrease by at least 10% to 7.6 by June 2020.
Strategy 1 Build awareness for staff and students.
Strategy 2 Systems of Support Advisor (SOSA)
End of Year SMARTR Outcome
Equity leads will have worked quarterly with core department CTs to develop their equity lens around access, opportunity, and support by June 2020
Strategy 1 Developing a sense of community among staff, and among staff and students to develop trust, relationships, and support toward equitable emotional and academic growth for students.
Strategy 2 Engaging in courageous conversations about access, opportunity and support to create deeper understanding of the impacts on students.
