End of Year SMARTR Outcome
Unadjusted math SOL scores will increase by at least 10% to at least: 74% for Hispanic students, 72% for Economically Disadvantaged students, 76% for Black students, and 53% for special education students by June 2021.

-Decrease the disproportionality in the discipline referrals of Black students to administration such that the discipline risk ratio for Black students is 1.99 or less.
-Increase participation in AP and Honors classes will increase by at least 10%. Black: 32% (AP); 49% (Honors) Hispanic: 28% (AP); 42% (Honors) Special Education: 10%; 20% (Honors) Economically Disadvantaged: 30% (AP); 40% (Honors)
