- Intensive educational experiences
- Focuses on one special area of interest
- Live on a college campus for four weeks
- Involvement in classroom and laboratory work, field studies, research, individual and group projects/performances, and seminars with noted scholars, visiting artists and other professionals

Selection Criteria

- Current 10th and 11th grade students
- Identified as gifted
- Able, motivated and mature
- Completion of application process by deadlines indicated
- Up to four week commitment (July)
- Strong teacher recommendations

Program Costs

- Tuition, room and board are paid for by FCPS
- Students must provide own spending money (approximately \$40-50 a week)
- Students must provide their own transportation to and from the program

Application Process

- Fill out, print and deliver the appropriate application and letters of recommendation to Mr. Shapiro or Ms. Bluestein by:
 - December 8, 2023 for Academics and Mentorships
 - **January 31, 2024** for Visual and Performing Arts
- No LATE applications will be accepted
- Request letters of recommendation (EARLY)
 - Specific format (Refer to online document for links, 2021 Virginia Summer Governor's School)
 - Teacher scales and recommendations are rated both should be <u>TYPED</u>!

Important Factors

Career Highlights

- Activities, research and honors
 - Rating scale for career highlights
- Academic Essay
 - Indicate your passion/desire to pursue in college
 - Have parents/teacher review before submitting
 - No essay needed for VPA
- Standardized Test Scores (Two)
 - PSAT, SAT, ACT, CogAT, and/or NNAT
- **GPA**
- Course Difficulty

Important Factors

Full Name

- Ensure that it is located in the top right hand corner of each page of your application
- Black Ink
 - For student and parent initials
- Request that your letters of recommendation to be typed and placed on letterhead
 - Current and/or previous teacher who can speak to your high level of academic rigor
 - Connect to the field in which you are applying

Timeline

- Academics Application December 2023
 - WPHS committee will review application packets and narrow candidate pools to school-based quotas
- VPA Application December 2023
 - Students applying for Visual and Performing Arts are notified of adjudication appointments by the Fine Arts Office for January 5-6, 2024 at Briar Woods High School

Timeline

January 2024

- Mr. Shapiro and Ms. Bluestein will submit the Academics applications of students moving forward in the process to the AAP Office
 - Students not moving forward will be notified by Mr. Shapiro and Ms. Bluestein in writing

February 2024

Mr. Shapiro and Ms. Bluestein will then submit the Visual and Performing Arts applications of students moving forward in the process to the AAP Office

Timeline

March 2024

Students will be notified if NOT selected (state level)

- April 2024
 - Virginia Department of Education in Richmond determines the final selection and will notify students of their final status
 - Strength of applicant pool
 - School division ranking
 - Needs of program indicated

No student is guaranteed acceptance to Governor's School
