WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Dual Enrollment (DE) is an opportunity that allows qualified high school students to earn college credits through Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA). For the 2020-21 school year, the dual enrollment tuition for NOVA is at no cost. DE courses are taught at Fairfax County High Schools by FCPS teachers who are also NOVA approved faculty.
